



PRE-BORN ULTRASOUND STANDARDS OF CARE

- A. The Pregnancy Center ultrasound program will operate under the supervision of a physician serving as the Medical Director. If the Medical Director does not have obstetrical experience, the Pregnancy Center should have a local physician with obstetrical training available for consultation.
- B. An ultrasound exam performed in a Pregnancy Center is a medical procedure requiring a positive pregnancy test and a physician's order and review. An ultrasound exam is usually performed to "confirm a positive intrauterine pregnancy, gestational age and fetal cardiac activity".
- C. The Pregnancy Center will adhere to all licensing requirements: Health Care Professionals will hold current state appropriate licensure, certification and/or registration. The Pregnancy Center will acquire any state licensure requirements and a CLIA waived test status to do urine pregnancy tests.
- D. The Pregnancy Center will obtain and maintain medical malpractice and liability insurance.
- E. The Pregnancy Center will adhere to OSHA standards.
- F. The Pregnancy Center will establish and follow a Medical Policy & Procedures Manual that is approved by the Board of Directors and Medical Director and reviewed annually.
- G. Written ultrasound reports, accompanied by video/print pictures, will be completed by the nurse doing the ultrasound scans.
- H. Every ultrasound report will be read and signed by a physician in a timely manner and filed in the client's medical file.
- I. Every abortion-vulnerable woman scanned will be given the opportunity to hear her babies heartbeat via Doppler function.
